Journeying alongside others

Acts 8.26-40

On the road to Gaza, Philip meets an Ethiopian court official who is reading from the prophet Isaiah. The passage begins, 'Like a sheep he was led to the slaughter'. Prompted by the Spirit, Philip asks the Ethiopian whether he understands what he is reading. The Ethiopian says he needs a guide. Philip uses this as an opportunity to speak about Jesus and the Ethiopian responds by asking to be baptized. Philip turns back towards Jerusalem, proclaiming the good news everywhere he goes.

Stepping out of your front door can be an adventure. Encountering somebody who can help us on our spiritual journey can change our lives. Think of your own journeys and how travelling with others can bring new insights, friendships, solace and we might even meet with Jesus!

These words are particularly poignant to me as I prepare for my next journey during my Sabbatical.
